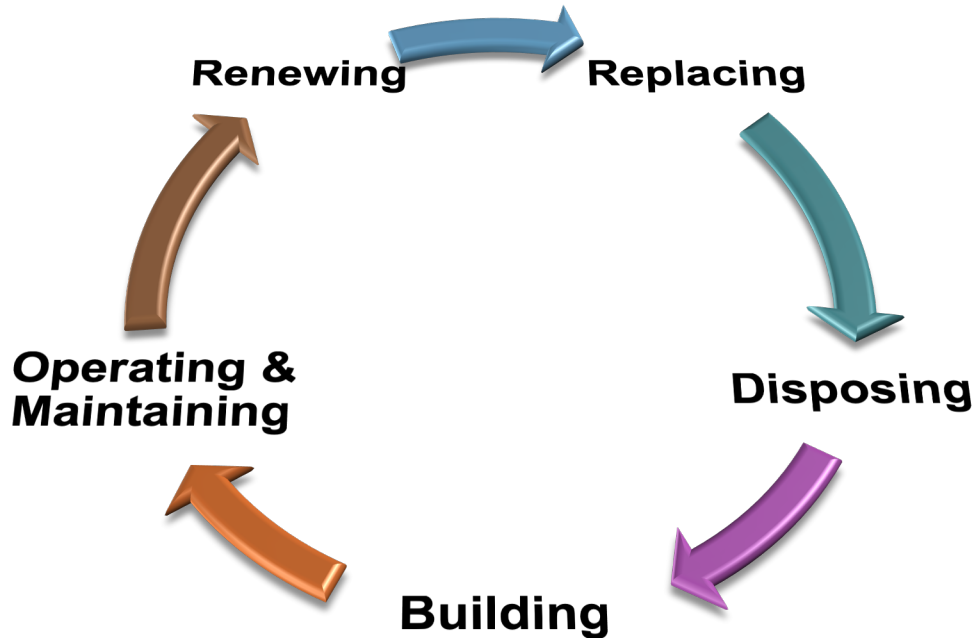

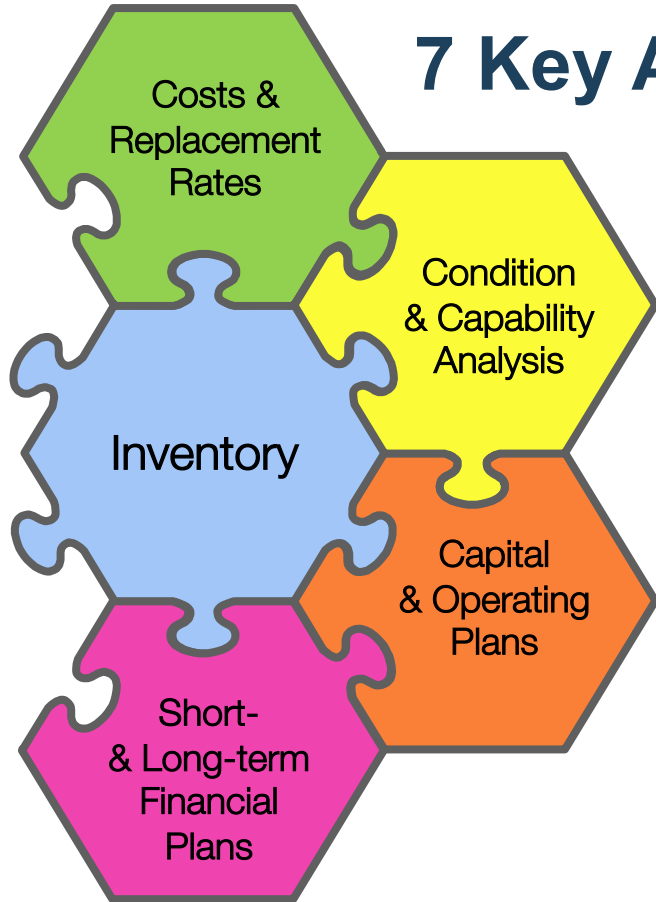
# Asset Management Planning is...

1. What do you have and where is it?
2. What is it worth?
3. What is its condition and expected remaining service life?
4. What is the level of service expectation, and what needs to be done?
5. When do you need to do it?
6. How much will it cost and what is the acceptable level of risk(s)?
7. How do you ensure long-term affordability?
