



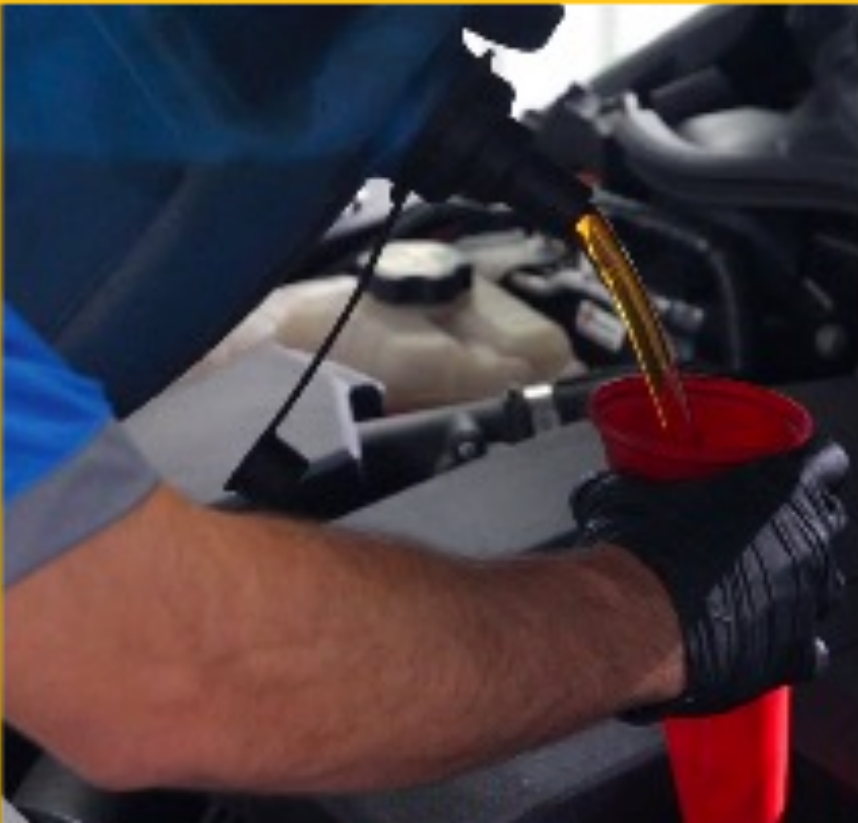

# Who Are We?

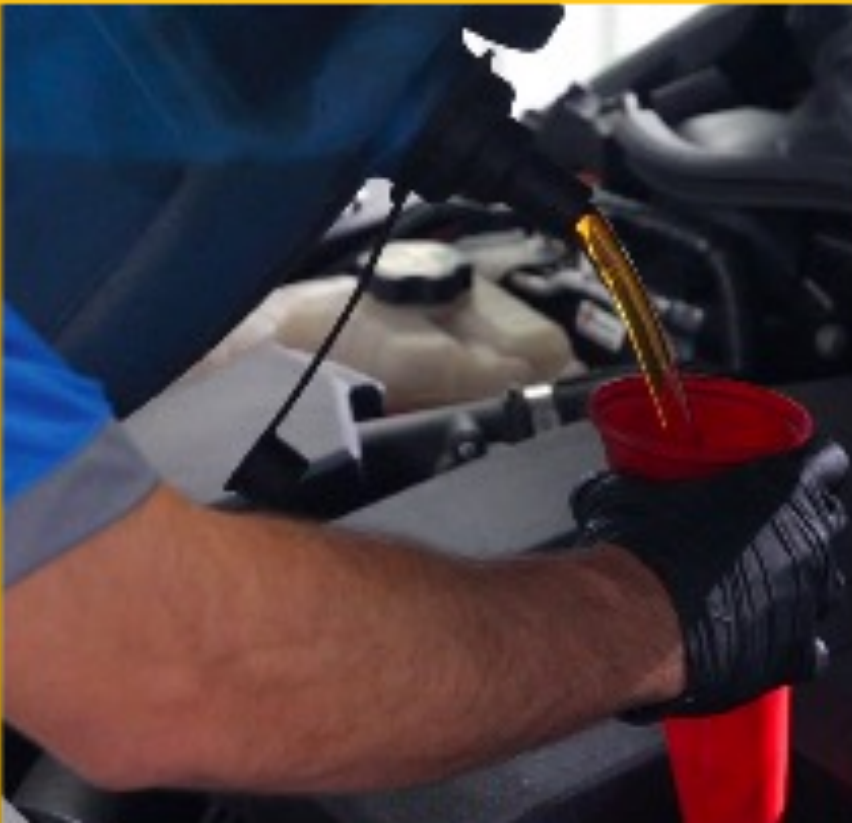
What do we do?.



- UOMA Atlantic is an industry organization set up to:
  - Bring together brand owners for recycling of used oil products
  - Create convenient way for **GENERATORS** and **CONSUMERS** to recycle used oil and glycol products
- UOMA Atlantic is the designated agency to manage the Used Oil and Glycol Program in NL



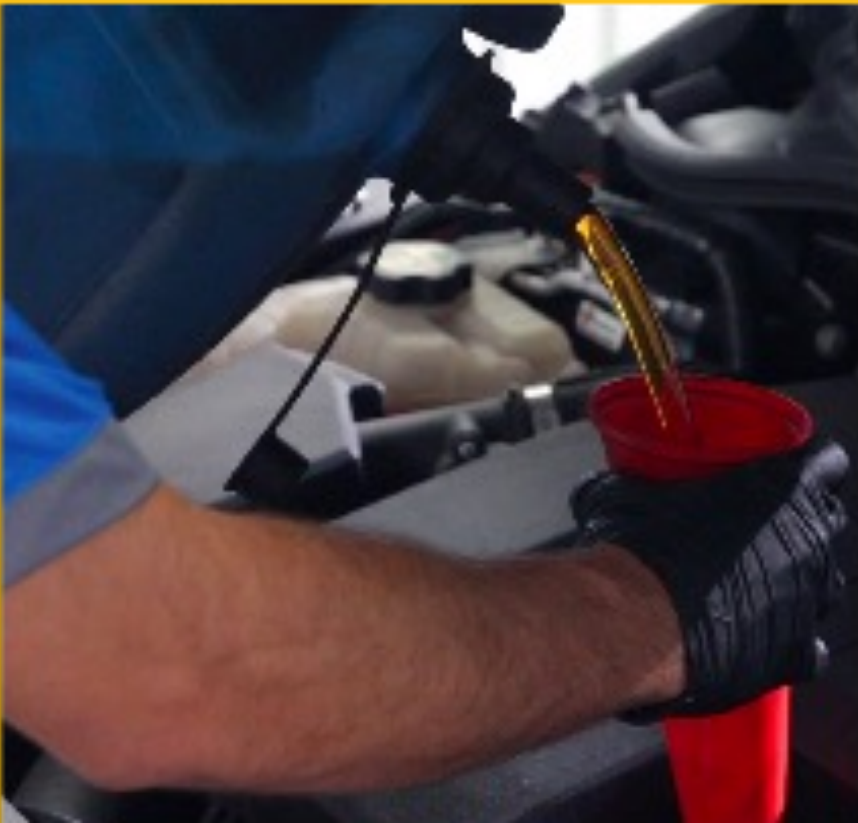
# What has Changed



- In 2019 the Province of NL introduced Regulations for the disposal and recycling of used oil and glycol products
- Products covered by the program cannot go to landfills
- Changes to the *Regulation* require industry to collect/recycle products
- Funding to run the program comes from an Environmental Handling Charge (EHC) on products covered in the program and sold in NL



# What Products Must be Recycled?





- Used Oil



- Used Oil Containers (50L or less)



- Used Oil Filters



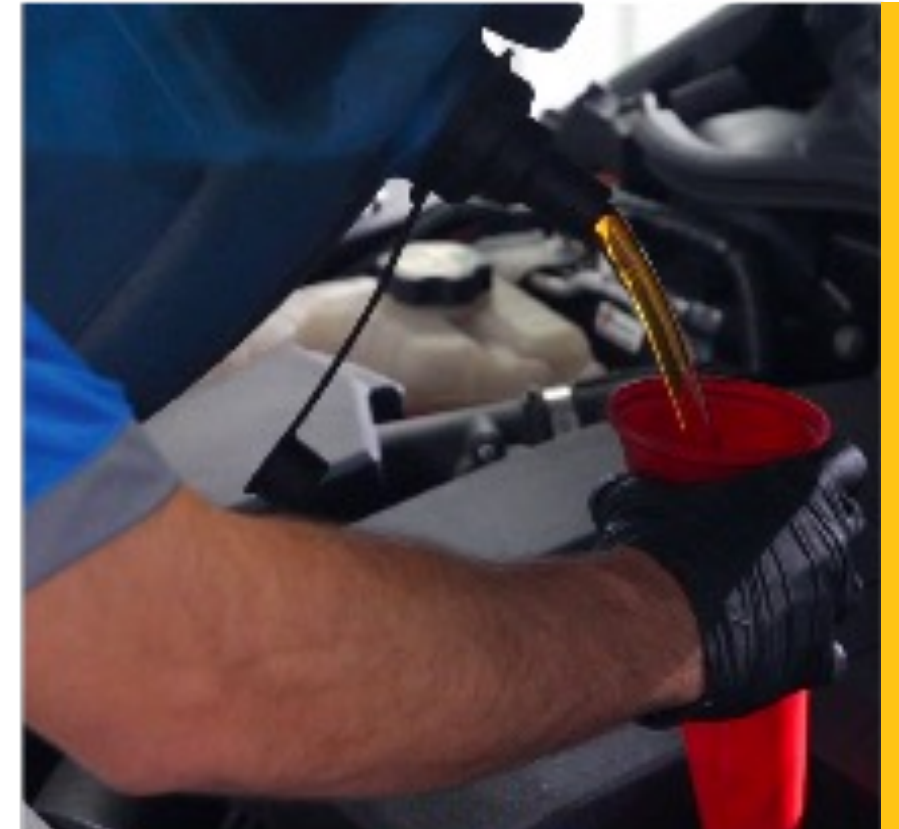
- Empty Aerosol Cans ( lubricating oil and brake cleaner)



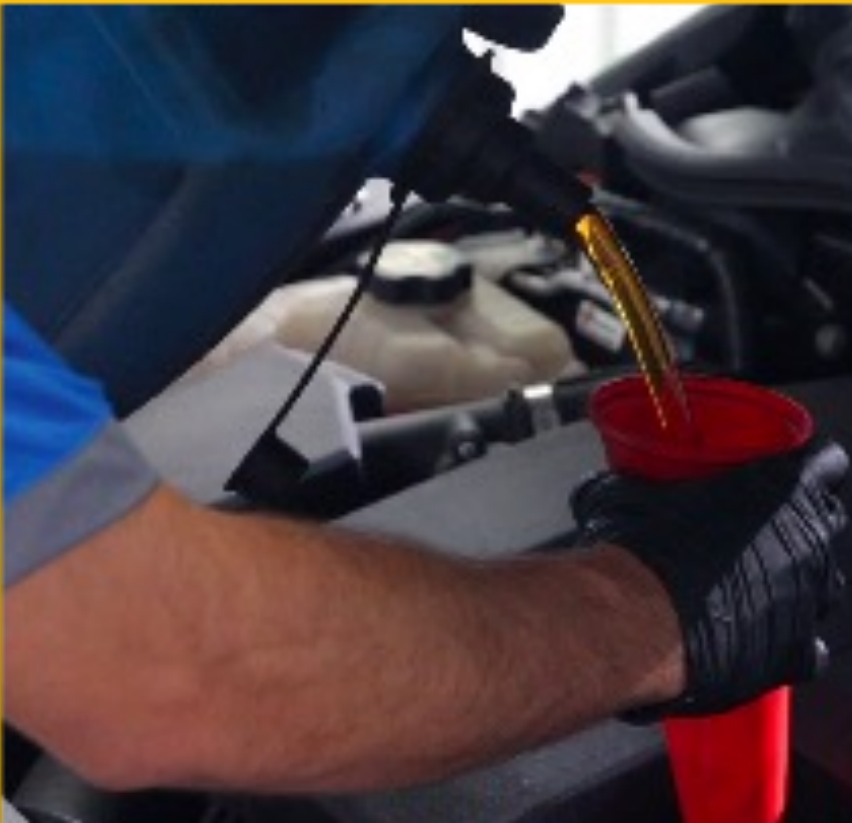
- Glycol/Antifreeze

- Glycol/Antifreeze Containers (50L or less)



# How Does It Work?



- UOMA Registered Collectors pick up from **Generators** of used oil products



- Collectors provide the bins/drums
- Set up a schedule to pick up depending on quantities generated



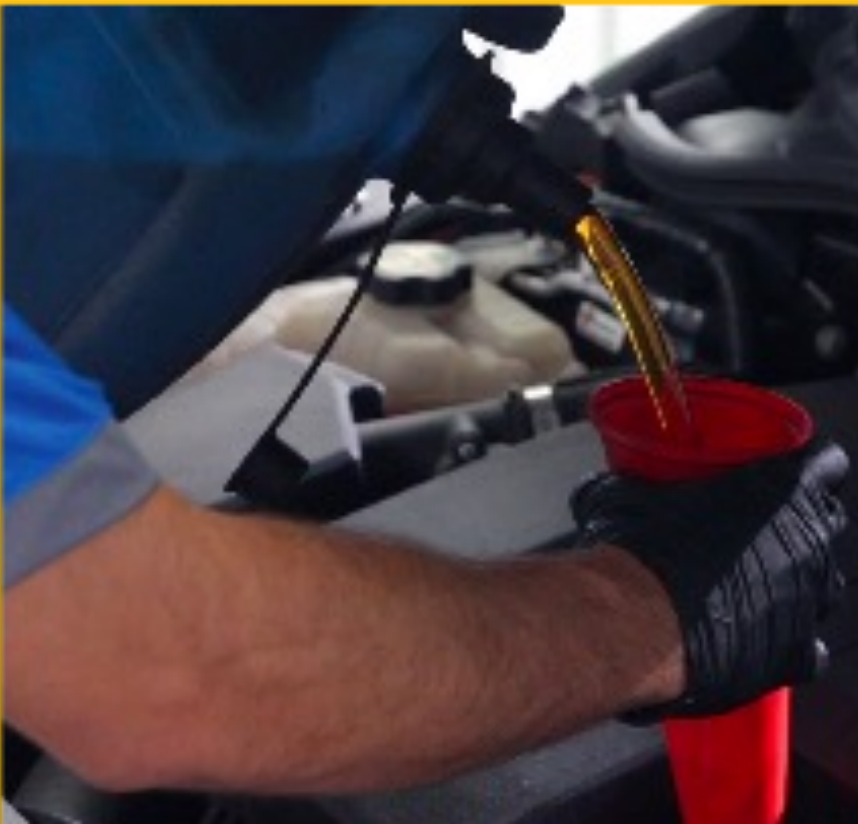
- **Consumers - Residents/DIYers** - drop off to a UOMA Collection Facility – a network of garages, etc.



- There is no cost to **Generators** for collection service or the bins and drums



How are we doing so far...



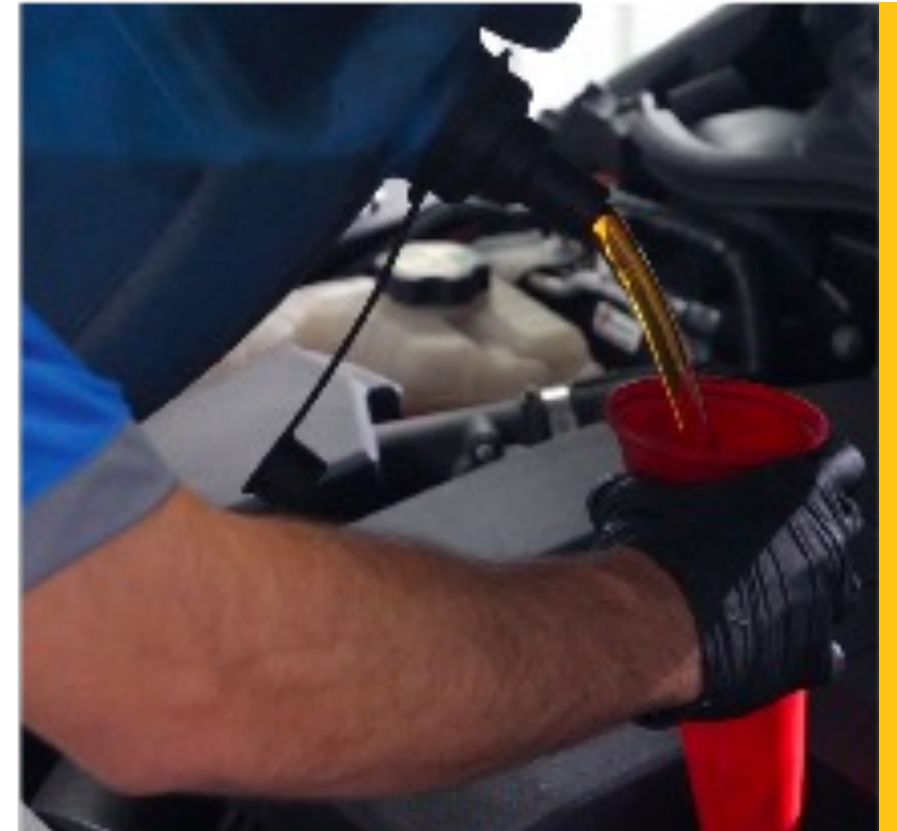
- In 2021 in NL



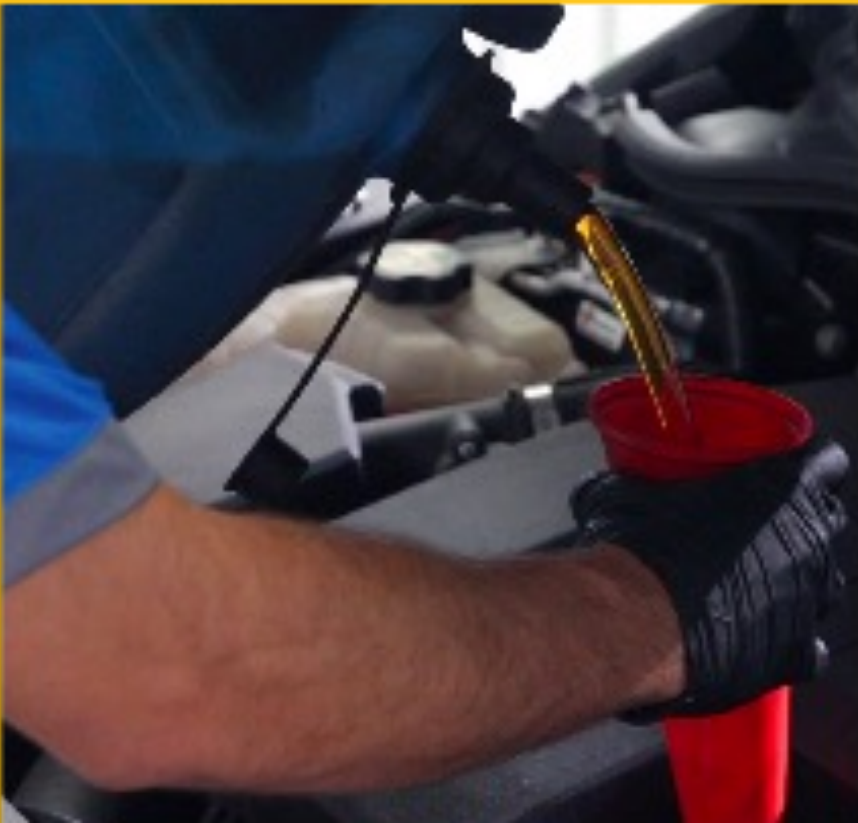

- **80%** of used oil was collected/recycled
- **56%** of used oil filters
- **39%** of oil containers
- **45%** of glycol/antifreeze
- **22%** of glycol/antifreeze containers

- Register to be a UOMA Collection facility for residents in your community
- Be a partner with UOMA to share information on your community website, bulletin boards, etc.
